

L3 Community Health & Wellbeing Worker

Community Health and Wellbeing Workers support individuals and communities to improve health, prevent ill-health and reduce inequalities by addressing the wider social determinants of health. Working across settings and sectors, they take a holistic, strengths-based approach, partnering with people to understand what matters to them, build resilience, and remove barriers to accessing support.

They connect individuals and communities to local services and resources, identify gaps in provision, and work collaboratively with statutory, voluntary and community organisations to develop solutions.

Key Development Areas

- ✔ **Prevention, behaviour change & individual wellbeing:** Develop the ability to address health and wellbeing needs using a whole-person approach that considers physical, mental, emotional and social factors, as well as the wider social determinants of health.
- ✔ **Community Development:** Build skills in working with individuals, groups and communities as equal partners, identifying strengths, assets and unmet needs, and supporting local resilience through collaboration with community organisations.
- ✔ **Information, Advice or Guidance:** Strengthen competence in understanding local services and resources, providing informed advice, managing referrals, reducing barriers to access, and helping people navigate complex health, care and community systems.
- ✔ **Collaborative Working:** Enhance the ability to build effective relationships across statutory, voluntary, community and private sectors, identify gaps in provision, and contribute to the development or coordination of services and initiatives that address health inequalities.
