Team Leader

A Team Leader plays a vital role in first-line management by ensuring the smooth running of a team, working towards business objectives, and supporting the development of the individual team members.

They provide leadership with operational and project responsibilities by offering direction, instructions and guidance to achieve targets and will often be responsible for ensuring tasks are correctly administered in line with current legislation and organisational policy.
